Bill Mielke of Village Park Drive, asked that if there was a petition done years ago for Lincoln Avenue to install speed bumps, and there was enough signatures, why wasn't it pursued.

Trustee Sim stated that we have to follow DOT standards, and there is more criteria to follow than just getting a petition. For speed bumps, there needs to be certain volume of traffic standards that need to be met, and when presented years ago for speed bumps, Lincoln Avenue did not meet the flow of traffic standards.
