Clerk Blot mentioned that tomorrow is the Villages Centennial. She thanked Katie Ciota for all her hard work on the website tab for the centennial. She also thanked Alexandra Hart and Courtney Sim for their centennial tributes on the facebook page. They will be putting memorabilia up daily on the facebook page.

Trustee Lockart listed the applicants that are scheduled to be on the agenda for the March 2, 2021 Planning Commission meeting.

Trustee White gave an update on the most recent Sign Review Board meeting.

Trustee Sim mentioned that we started working on the 2021-2022 budget. He added it's been a lot of work and thanked all for their involvement. He mentioned that the first draft should be ready soon for review. Trustee Sim also wished the Village of Colonie a Happy 100th Birthday.

Mayor Tobin talked about the Centennial. He stated there is a special edition Villager that is going out that has a lot of history and memorabilia in it for the Centennial. HE also mentioned that we plan to celebrate our Centennial with regularly scheduled events in 2022 due to COVID-19. He thanked Katie Ciota, Carl Fleshman and Brian Casey for their work on the Villager and added it was very impressive. He also mentioned he spoke with former Mayor Chuck Milton, he is the only other living Mayor besides himself and former Mayor Sim. Mayor Tobin also mentioned we are working on the 2021-2022 budget, and it was great getting input from our board and department heads. Mayor Tobin also stated that we have re-opened a number of our public buildings to access for regular business. He noted that our senior center and outreach center will remain closed to the public, but will continue the drive-through lunch program and helping our residents and seniors. He also noted that there should be no more than 15 people for any public gatherings currently. He asked everyone to continue wearing their masks and socially distancing. He mentioned that we are tentatively planning to begin rental requests for April 1st for the 2021 season. He mentioned that we changed the process a little and will monitor those changes. We continue to try to get back to normal.
