Mr. Garvey asked if the Village has ever looked into solar energy, to which Deputy Mayor Sim stated the Village required places to put such equipment and with the lease options it wasn't feasible. Mr. Garvey stated he was dismayed he was not allowed to attend the Village of Menands board meetings in-person until January 2022 due to COVID. Mayor Tobin thanked Mr. Garvey for attending tonight's meeting and said the board would look over the items presented by him.
